PROCLAMATION

1. Recognizing National Gun Violence Awareness Day

RESOLUTIONS: (13)

1. Authorizing the Township to abate a nuisance property located at Block 6202, Lot 6 (17 Normandy Road)

The owners of 17 Normandy Road have failed to maintain the exterior of their property, creating a nuisance. A notice of violation and order of abatement was issued and rectified. The Township needs to abate the nuisance and a lien will be assessed against the property.

2. Endorsing Mount Olive Township's Municipal Alliance application for funding to the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse

The Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances to educate and engage residents, local government, law enforcement officials, schools and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse. Grant funding is available through the County of Morris and a strategic plan needs to be submitted along with the grant application.

3. Authorizing participation in the Lead Grant Assistance Program

The State has made available a \$7K grant for a Lead Assistance Program which needs to be inserted into the budget as revenue in order to be made available as an appropriation.

4. Requesting approval from the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for insertion of a specific item of revenue into the 2023 Municipal Budget (\$76,008.15 for Clean Communities Program)

The State has made available a \$76,008.15 grant for Clean Communities which needs to be inserted into the budget as revenue in order to be made available as an appropriation.

5. Requesting approval from the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for insertion of a specific item of revenue into the 2023 Municipal Budget (\$7,000 for Lead Grant Assistant Program)

The DCA has allocated \$7,000 to the Township of Mount Olive for the purpose of assisting in municipal compliance related to the Lead Based Paint legislation.

6. Authorizing the award of contract for the purchase of four (4) 2023 Chevrolet Tahoes off NJ State Contract (Gentilini Motors)

The Township needs to purchase four (4) 2023 Chevrolet Tahoes for the Police Department which is available off a New Jersey state contract through Gentilini Motors not to exceed \$188,325.88, which includes all applicable equipment to outfit each vehicle.

7. Authorizing the award of contract for the purchase of four (4) portable light towers off of Bergen County Co-Op (Montague Tool & Supply Co.)

The Township needs to purchase four (4) portable light towers with generators for the Recreation and Public Works Department which are available off a Bergen County Coop through Wacker Light Tower, not to exceed \$41,272.

8. Authorizing the award of a one-year contract extension (Year 2/Final) to Peterson and Sons Tree Service for Bid #15-2019 Tree Removal, Tree Trimming & Stump Grinding (October 30, 2022 - October 29, 2023) Revised - Increasing contract amount

Increasing the contract amount for Tree Removal, Tree Trimming & Stump Grinding services to Peterson and Sons Tree Service by \$42,000 for work needed at the Tarn to remove dead, deceased and unsafe trees.

9. Authorizing the award of a contract extension (Year 4/Final) for Bid #04-2020 Maintenance and Repair Services for Heating, Ventilating, and Air Conditioning Systems for Mount Olive Township Facilities (Reiner Group) Revised - Correcting optional year four/final cost

Revising a resolution approved on May 2, 2023 which extended a contract for Maintenance and Repair Services for HVAC systems to the Reiner Group to correct a typo in pricing.

10. Authorizing the award of a professional service agreement for Engineering and Construction Administration Services - Water Main Replacement & Well Building Rehabilitation at Glenside Drive & Sand Shore Well Building (Van Cleef Engineering Associates) Revised - Change in scope of work and contract amount

Revising a contract to change the scope of work and contact amount to Van Cleef Engineering to develop plans to replace waterlines at Glenside Drive and Kennedy Drive. The original scope of work was to include the rehabilitation of the Sand Shore well house which is being removed and will be funded through a separate

project. Kennedy Drive has been added to this scope of work and the contract is being reduced by \$5,000 to \$81,500.

11. Approving a non-fair and open vendor service contract pursuant to New Jersey Local Unit Pay-to-Play law (Brent Material Company)

The Township has a need to purchase residential fire hydrants as a non-fair and open contract in accordance with the Pay-to-Play law to Brent Material Company not to exceed \$31,664.

12. Authorizing the use of Bergen County Cooperative Pricing System Contract for 2023 (Various Vendors)

The Township needs to purchase various commercial grounds maintenance equipment and accessories which are available off of a Bergen County Co-op from the following vendors: Cherry Valley Tractor Sales, Montague Tool & Supply, Storr Tractor Company and US Municipal Supply.

13. Authorizing purchases off New Jersey State Contracts pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:11-12 for calendar year 2023 (ESI Equipment Inc.)

The Township needs to purchase firefighter protective clothing and equipment off a New Jersey State contract from ESI Equipment Inc.

The Health Department requests to create a part time Accreditation Coordinator to assist the Township in receiving their Health Accreditation. Accreditation is becoming a national standard for public health which demonstrates a commitment in achieving high standards for public health services, leadership and accountability.
