1. Adopting the 2024-2025 updated version of the Personnel Policy and Procedures Manual & Employee Handbook

Every two years, to qualify for a deductible incentive program through the MEL JIF, members are required to adopt the MEL's model employment practices to reduce the employers liability. The model documents have been changed in an attempt to streamline the Manual and Handbook, remove policies which have been deemed to be unnecessary and not required under law.

2. Waiving construction permit fees to the Mount Olive Child Care and Learning Center related to the child care facilities improvement grant

The Township has the right to waive certain fees. The Mount Olive Child Care and Learning Center has requested permit fees be waived for costs associated with roof renovations which is being grant funded. The Township owns the building. 3. Authorizing the application and execution of the FFY2022 and FFY2023 NJ Transit 5310 grant application for operating project costs for the Senior Transportation Program

The Health Department is requesting authorization to apply for a grant through NJ Transit to help offset costs associated with the Senior Transportation Program.

4. Authorizing the award of a non-fair and open professional services agreement with RJH Law Enforcement Consultants for services of a hearing officer (December 1, 2022 - December 31, 2023)

The professional service with RJH Law Enforcement Consultants needs to be amended to comply with pay to play laws as the estimated value may exceed \$17,500. In addition, the contract term needs to be extended through the end of the year to finish up the disciplinary hearings.

5. Authorizing the award of a contract for the purchase of snowplow and truck accessories off the ESCNJ Co-Op (A&K Equipment)

The Township desires to purchase snowplow and truck accessories to upfit the three 2024 DPW pickup trucks through an ESCNJ Co-Op through A&K Equipment not to exceed \$43,346.03.

6. Authorizing the award of a one year contract extension (year 1) to George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. for bid #4-2022 furnish and delivery of water and wastewater treatment chemicals

The Township previously awarded a contract to George s. Coyne Chemical Co. to furnish and deliver water and wastewater treatment chemicals. The contract will expire on December 17, 2023 and it is recommended to extend the contract for a one-year period under the same terms for items #2, 7, 8 & 9. Due to rising costs in the marketplace both in material and freight, items #3 & 4 need to be adjusted as allowed per the contract.

7. Approving a non-fair and open vendor service contract pursuant to New Jersey Local Unit pay-to-play law (USA Blue Book)

The Township has a need to acquire equipment, supplies, parts and tools as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to local pay-to-play law through USA Blue Book not to exceed \$21,200.

8. Authorizing the award of a contract for the purchase of handgun accessories off two New Jersey state contracts (Atlantic Tactical)

The Township has a need to purchase handgun accessories off of two NJ state contracts from Atlantic Tactical not to exceed \$31,115.67.

9. Closing Hampton Road between Falcon Road and Ledgewood Road on October 7th, between 12 pm and 8 pm for the purpose of holding a block party (rain date -October 8th)

A resident has petitioned for a road closure on Hamtpon Road between Falcon Road and Ledgewood Road for the purposes of a block party on October 7th, 2023 from 12pm - 8 pm.

10. Authorizing release of bonds to Gold Mine Road Solar, LLC in connection with development of a solar facility on Block 4100, Lot 10 (149 Gold Mine Road) The Developer of 149 Gold Mine Road has requested the release of certain bonds and escrows related to the Gold Mine Road Solar development. The Township Conflict Engineer has reviewed the requests, completed the general site inspections and determined the construction is in compliance with the plans and has no objection to the release of the bonds and escrow, subject to a two-year maintenance bond.

11. Authorizing the emergency purchase of a PFAS treatment system for the repair of the Pinecrest watersystem

The Pinecrest Water system has elevated levels of PFAS/PFOA which needs immediate attention. AdEdge has submitted a proposal to provide a filtration system which has been approved by the DEP, not to exceed \$215,560. There is a 24-26 week lead time. A separate contract will be issued for the installation.
